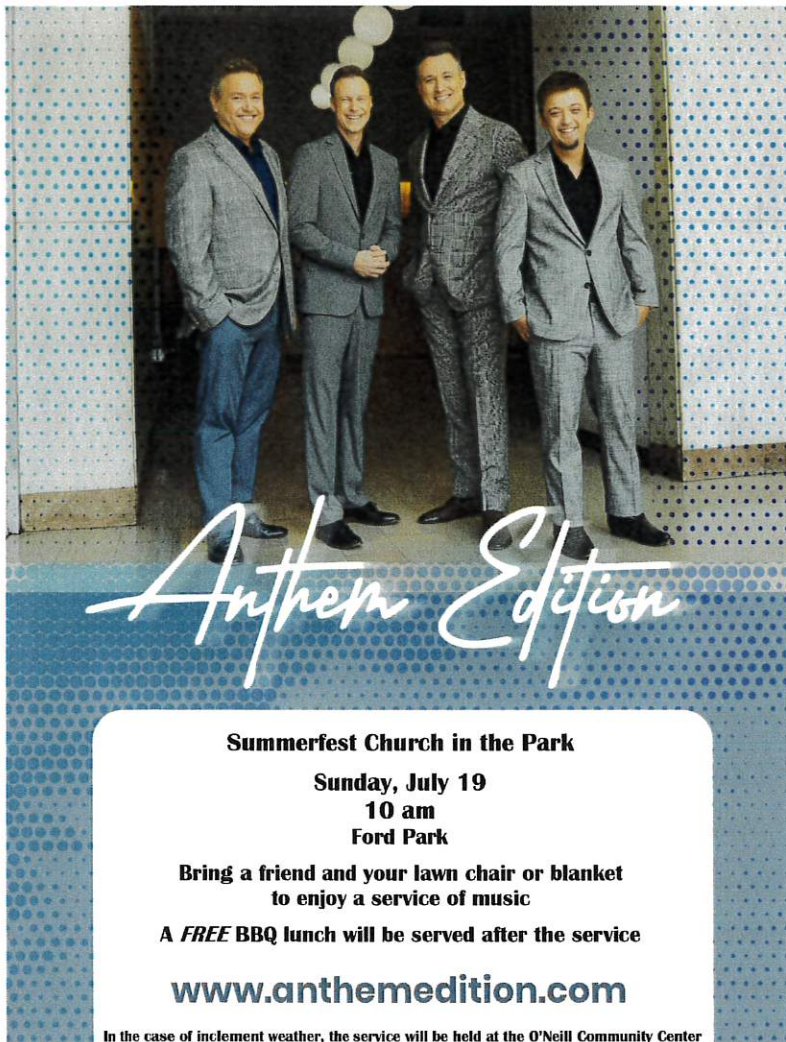

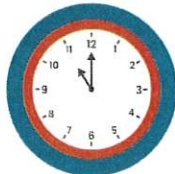

ABOUT THE GUIDE

What is the guide?

A free, searchable online directory of physical activity opportunities across the North Central District — from sports leagues to parks and one-time events.

How do I find it?

Visit ncdhd.ne.gov/physical-activities directly, navigate from the NCDHD main site, or scan the QR code on a printed handout.

How do I search it?

The guide is searchable by county and by activity type — no account or login needed.

WHAT'S ON THE GUIDE

What activities are listed?

Adult & children's sports leagues, school sports, walking paths, city parks, pools, golf courses, fitness classes, gyms, studios, Turkey Trots, color runs, marathons, festival races, special events, and even informal gatherings like a weekly walking group.

Are one-time events included?

Yes — ongoing activities and one-time events (Turkey Trots, color runs, marathon fundraisers, festival races) are both welcome. If it gets people moving, it belongs on the guide.

ADDING & UPDATING LISTINGS

How do I add or update a listing?

Anyone can submit a new listing or request an update using the submit box on the guide page — no fee, no special permission required.

Can a business or class be listed?

Yes! Any place, business, or class offering a physical activity opportunity qualifies — gyms, studios, pools, golf courses, parks, trails, and more. Even an informal group that simply meets to walk, play, or stay active counts — it doesn't have to be an official program.

SHARING & OUTREACH

How can I share the guide?

Printed QR code handouts (great for welcome bags), social media posts, direct links in emails/newsletters, or by embedding the link on your website.

Can organizations link to it?

Absolutely — schools, cities, businesses, and community groups are encouraged to link to ncdhd.ne.gov/physical-activities from their own sites and social pages.

New to the area? Look for a printed handout in your welcome bag — scan the QR code to instantly browse activities and events near you by county. The guide is free, always up to date, and easy to share.

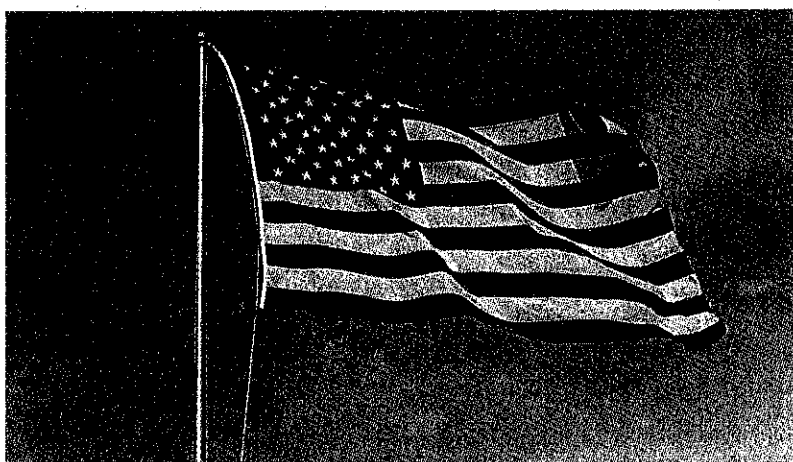
