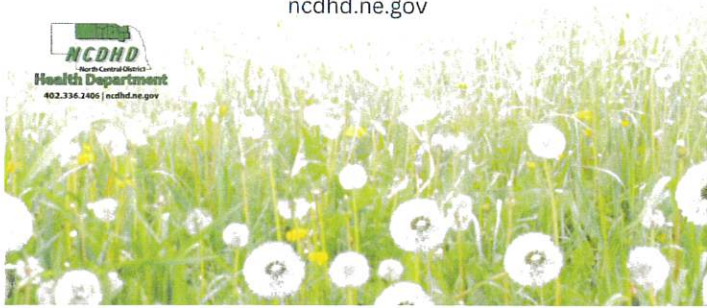

Cereal rye can be an excellent early spring grazing resource. However, because it grows rapidly, it can be challenging to apply the right grazing pressure to optimize animal performance and maintain forage quality.

Have you ever asked yourself:

- How many animals should I put in that pasture?
- How long can they stay?
- How much forage is actually out there?

To help answer these common questions, we developed Snap2Graze, a web-based decision support tool designed specifically for cereal rye pastures. Head to the link above for more info.

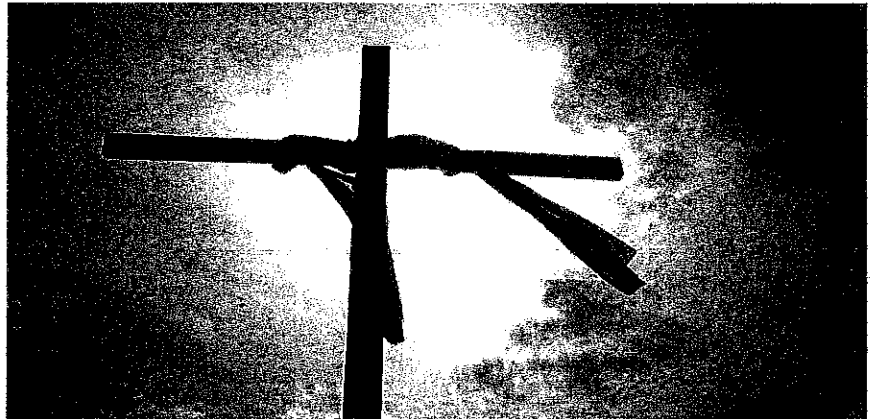
