


Sam Barber, singer and songwriter from Southeast Missouri has seen his career skyrocket over the last couple of years. He had a very busy 2024 touring schedule, and is excited to be out on his jam packed 2025 North American Tour. In October of 2024, Barber released his *Restless Mind* album. 
